

ABOUT THIS COURSE

Through real-world examples, current safety research, and hands-on learning, we will explore why personal protective equipment (PPE) matters for everyone on site, not just field crews. Participants will review data demonstrating the impact of hazard awareness training and learn proven methods for helping workers "see" safety before incidents occur. The course will also clarify the purpose behind regulatory requirements and show how tools like Job Safety Analyses (JSA), Job Hazard Analyses (JHA), and Safe



Starts improve shared understanding of risk. Finally, attendees will gain practical guidance for implementing health and safety best practices that are realistic, maintainable, and effective throughout design, construction, and facility operations.

HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE JUSTIFICATION

This course directly supports Health, Safety, and Welfare by equipping participants with knowledge and skills that reduce risk of injury on construction sites and improve the long-term safety of built environments. Attendees will learn to identify hazards, understand the purpose and application of regulatory safety requirements, and implement best practices that protect workers, design professionals, and the public. By emphasizing PPE use, hazard recognition through tools such as JSA/JHA/Safe Starts, and integration of safety considerations during the design phase, the course advances participant competency in creating safer construction processes and healthier project outcomes. Each component of the training is focused on safeguarding human life and well-being, consistent with AIA HSW criteria.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- 1. **Dress for Success:** PPE isn't just for workers: Learn why and how PPE plays an important role for everyone who works, supervises, manages and tours construction work sites.
- 2. **Reviewing statistics on how teaching workers to see safety makes a difference:** Learn effective strategies to minimize worker injury. Training, discussions and hands-on-site reviews.
- 3. **Regulatory purpose:** Gain understanding the purpose of regulatory requirements and why identifying hazards through JSA, JHA, and Safe Starts helps workers to understand why safety regulations exist. Learn how factoring in safety during design goes beyond the construction phase.
- 4. **Implement Best Practices for Health and Safety:** Learn how to apply best management practices that workers can and will adhere to.


