



## WHAT I LEARNED FROM CSI...

### WATER CLOSET (TOILET) FLANGES AND WAX SEALS




A friend recently called about the wax seal and a water closet flange repair at their residence. Some readers may be familiar with this, but a toilet is “bolted” down to the sewer pipe flange with t-bolts and nuts which are sealed water tight to the piping with a wax seal as shown in the diagram below. The photo which the friend emailed indicated the flange was installed too high for the adjacent floor tile and the wax seal was leaking around the base of the toilet. Since I had personally replaced several toilets in my life, I was familiar with the wax seal and toilet setting process, but was not aware of the many different types of seals and water closet flanges available.



As a plumbing engineer, I was surprised at the variety of water closet flanges available along with the number of wax seal alternatives. Water closet flanges are available in several different materials and configurations as shown by the screen shot below. According to one plumbing supply sales representative, PVC flanges are subject to breakage if the toilet nuts and bolts are torqued too tight. The stainless steel flange can also bend if too much torque is applied. The cast iron flanges will not normally crack, but the porcelain base of the toilet might break if too much torque is applied. Most toilet flange bolt holes have some adjustment capability, but it is important to orient the flange so that the bolt holes and the toilet can be installed square to the walls. The offset toilet flanges is often used when the toilet is located over a structural member and allows the toilet to be set in the optimum location adjacent to the toilet room walls. All of the water closet flanges below are compatible with and/or can be replaced with wax seals.

The wax seal is a petroleum based wax that has a melting point of approximately 150 degrees F. If the wax seal needs to be replaced, the wax seal residue left on the flange or toilet base can be cleaned with rubbing alcohol. 
